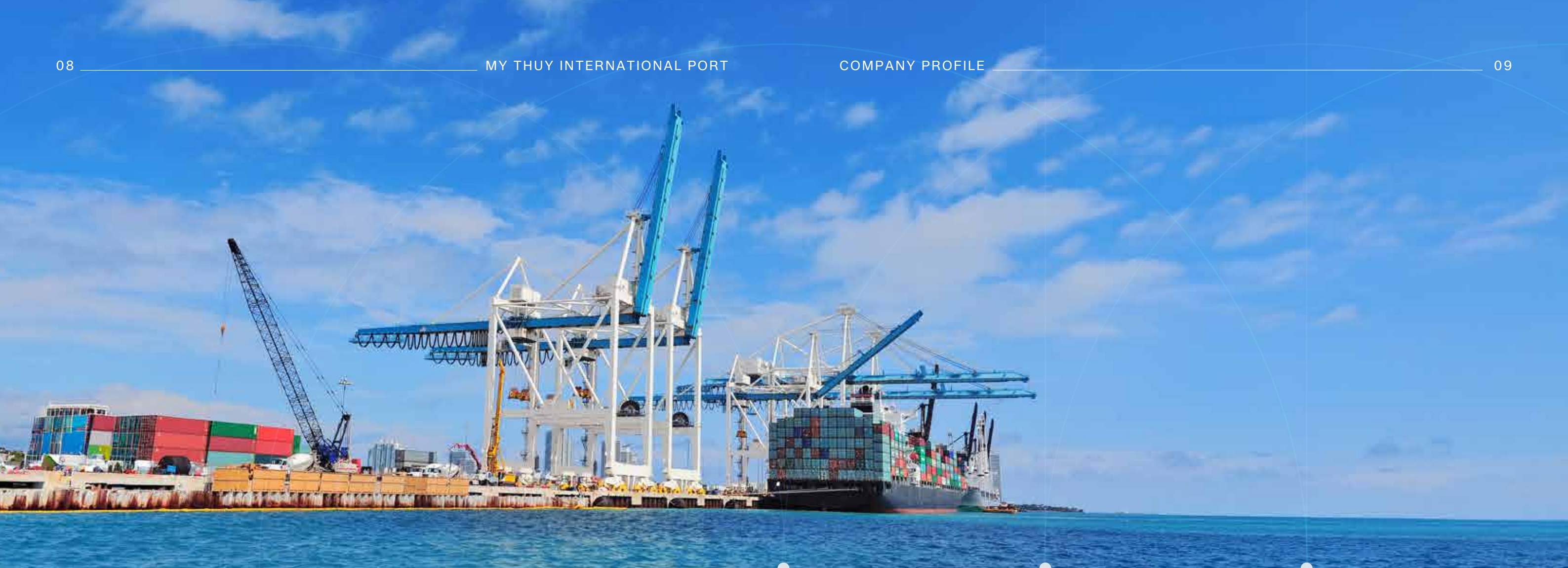

MARKET CONTEXT & STRATEGIC OPPORTUNITIES

My Thuy International Port possesses an elite geographical location, heavy-tonnage vessel handling capabilities, an abundance of clean energy resources, and a firm commitment to green and digital port development. This synergy establishes a solid foundation to transform Quang Tri into a new logistics powerhouse for Central Vietnam and the wider Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS).

LOGISTICS IN VIETNAM

Vietnam is entering a new era of growth, driven by a maritime-centric development strategy aimed at expanding its economic space and elevating its national standing on the global stage.

Logistics Efficiency Gap: Logistics currently contributes approximately 4-5% to the national GDP; however, logistics costs remain high at 16-17% of GDP, substantially above the global average.

Trade Dynamics: The boom in e-commerce, booming industrial manufacturing (particularly in electronics and semiconductors), and major Free Trade Agreements (CPTPP, EVFTA, RCEP) are injected with robust momentum into the sector.

National Strategic Vision: Under Vietnam's Logistics Development Strategy through 2035, with a Vision toward 2050, the country aims to slash logistics costs to below 12% of GDP. This will be achieved by aggressively expanding the seaport infrastructure, driving green and digital transformations, and positioning the nation as a premier global Free Trade hub.

SEA

The region is rapidly emerging as a critical alternative destination within global supply chains. There is a surging demand for modern deep-water port infrastructure and seamless connectivity across intra-regional maritime transport networks.

ASIA

East-West and Intra-Asia shipping lanes maintain stable and consistent growth. Deep-water ports capable of accommodating mega-vessels exceeding 100,000 DWT hold a distinct and decisive competitive edge.

GLOBAL

The shift toward supply chain greening, digitalization, and sustainable logistics is actively reshaping the global maritime industry. Seaports pioneering Green Port and Digital Port standards will secure an overwhelming advantage in attracting international shipping lines and global institutional investors.

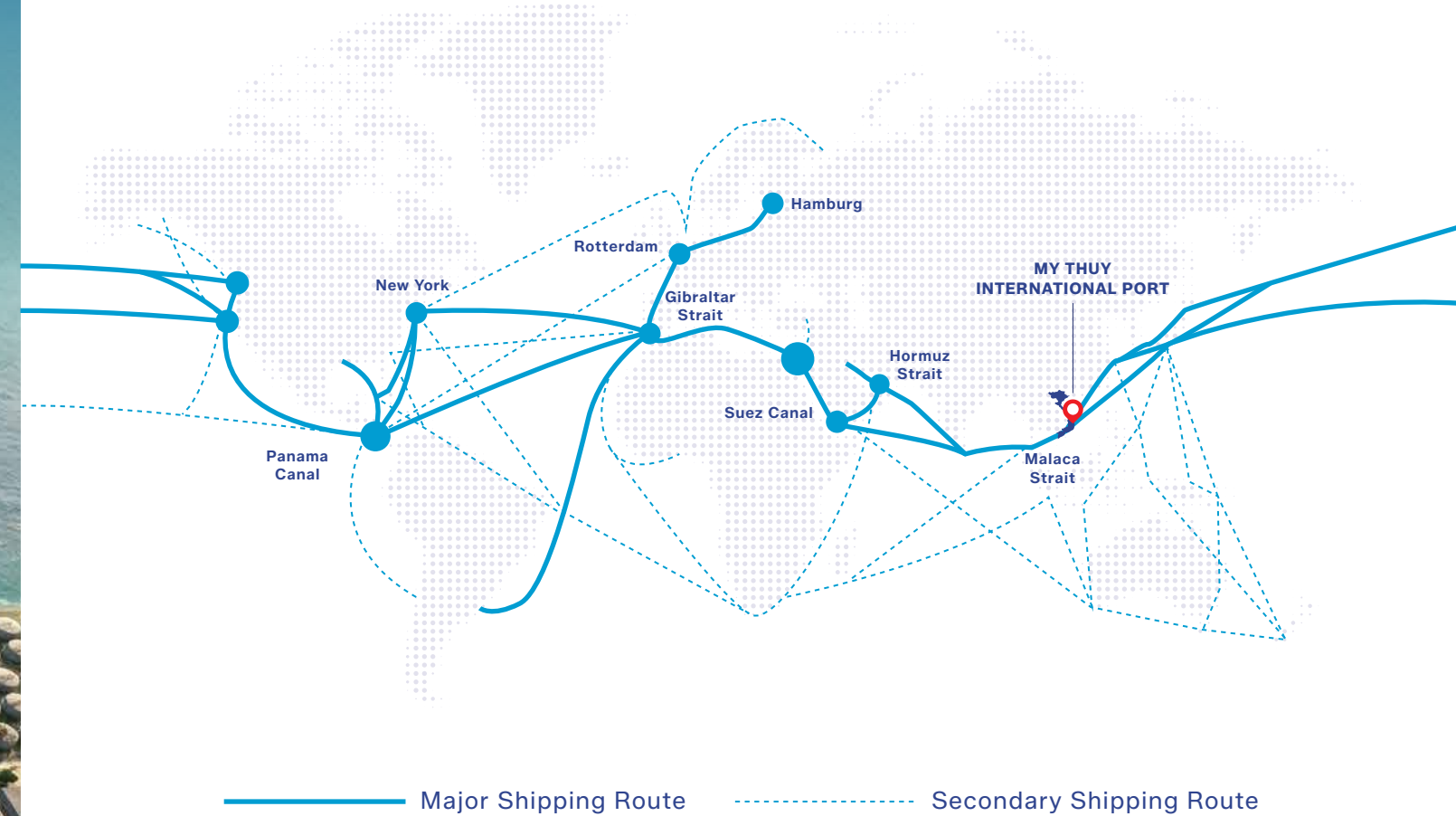
Quang Tri sits at the strategic intersection of **National Highway 1A, the North-South Expressway, and the East-West Economic Corridor (EWEC).**

This rare **"dual advantage"** positions My Thuy International Port as a vital nexus bridging intra-Asia supply chains with global maritime trade lanes.



A UNIQUE GEO-ECONOMIC LOCATION

My Thuy International Port is situated precisely at the eastern terminus of the East-West Economic Corridor (EWEC), one of the most critical economic corridors within the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS).



Leveraging its **"dual gateway"** positioning, rapidly maturing infrastructure, and a vision focused on building a modern Integrated Logistics Hub, the port serves as a new growth engine for Quang Tri and the Central Region. This establishes the very foundation for Quang Tri Province to transform itself—evolving from a **historic, heroic frontline and Demilitarized Zone (DMZ)** into a pivotal logistics powerhouse, a **Free Trade Zone (FTZ)**, and a **premier hub for cross-border trade** in Vietnam over the coming decade.



My Thuy Port provides the most efficient gateway to the Kunming–Vientiane–Bangkok international railway corridor, directly connected via the planned Khon Kaen–Savannakhet–Lao Bao rail link.



The port also connects directly to Vietnam's key North–South transport corridor through National Highway 1A, the North–South Expressway, and the national railway network.



The **"Golden Coordinate"**: Amid regional supply chain restructuring, My Thuy Port occupies a prime strategic location with the potential to reshape the region's logistics landscape.

LONG-TERM POTENTIAL

High-Potential Domestic & Transit Market

Catering directly to the Quang Tri Southeast Economic Zone and adjacent industrial parks. Most notably, the port serves as a primary gateway for transit cargo from Laos (minerals, agricultural products, energy) and Northeast Thailand—a rapidly expanding industrial manufacturing region.

A True Deep-Water Seaport

Capable of accommodating vessels up to 100,000 DWT. This deep-draft capacity significantly slashes logistics costs compared to other regional ports, while successfully attracting major global shipping lines.

Geo-Political Potential

Amid rising geopolitical dynamics in the South China Sea and the aggressive diversification of global supply chains, Vietnam stands out as a safe, highly efficient, and strategic choice for international investors looking to tap into the GMS market.

6 MODES OF TRANSPORTATION



Roadways

National Highway 1A, National Highway 15D, with seamless integration into the North-South Expressway in the near future.



Railways

Planned connections to the Dong Ha Station, the North-South national railway, and the cross-border Laos-Thailand railway network.



Maritime

Direct connectivity to major global shipping lanes.



Airways

Strategically located near the upcoming Quang Tri Airport and other major aviation hubs in Central Vietnam.



Pipelines

Feasibility studies are underway for a specialized liquid bulk pipeline system stretching to Laos.



Conveyor Systems

Utilizing high-capacity industrial conveyor belt networks to streamline and optimize bulk cargo distribution alongside roadways.

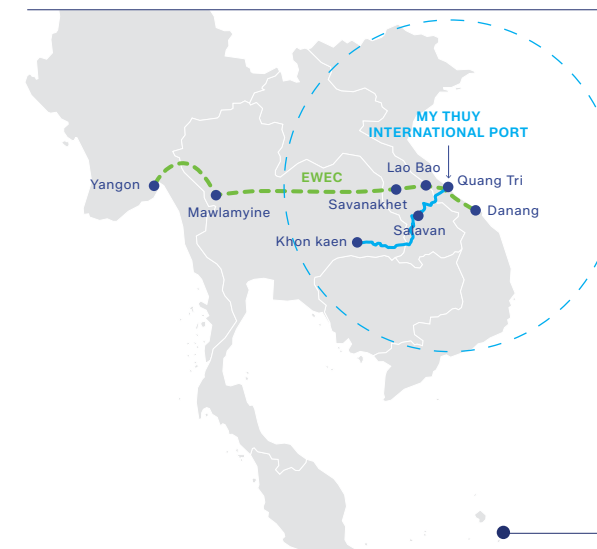

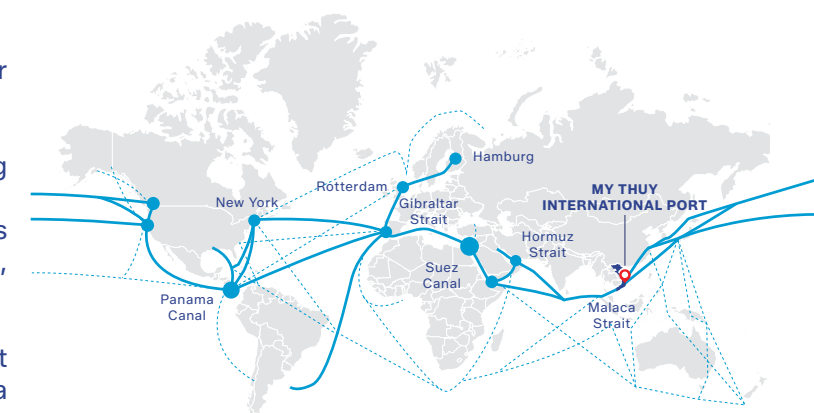

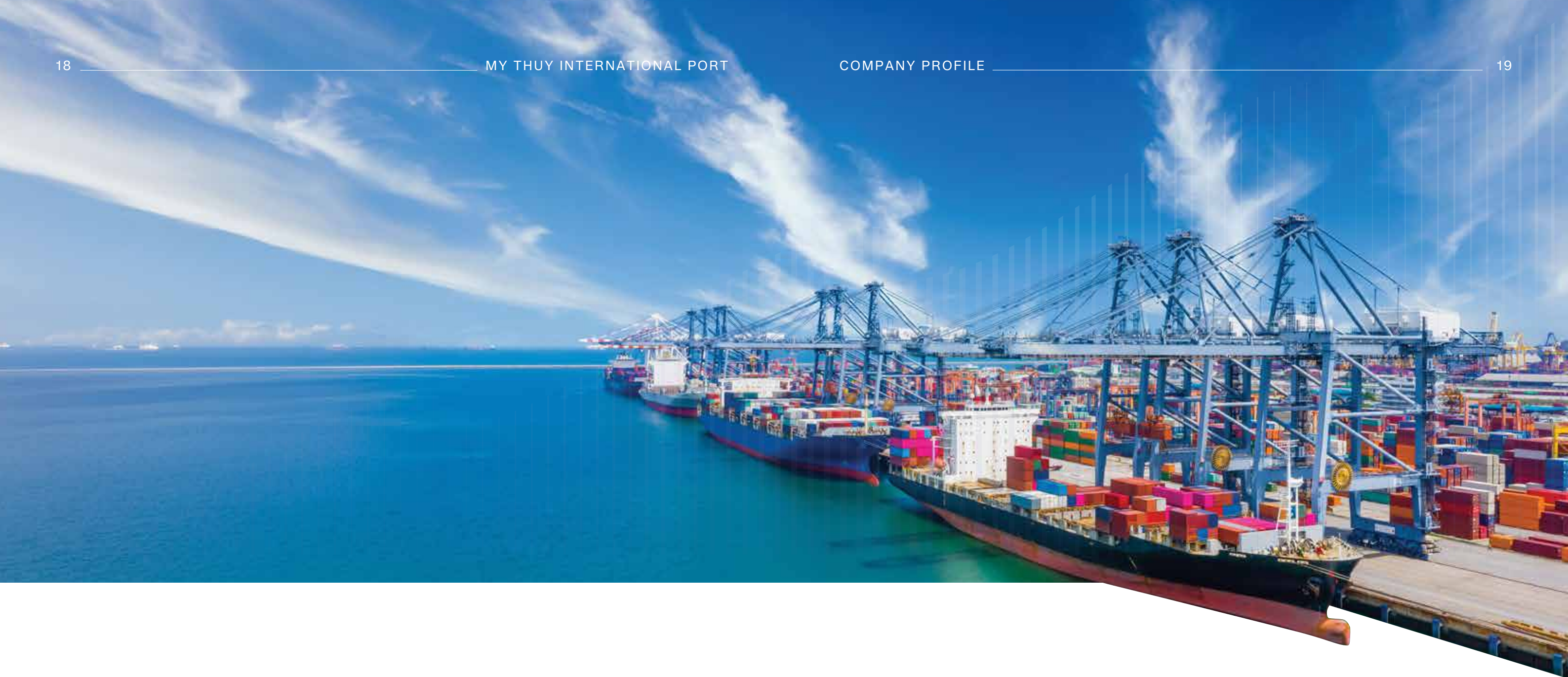

The project is designed with a synchronized and ultra-modern layout, driving toward automated terminal operations and stringently adhering to green port standards. This ensures the capacity to fulfill the rapidly escalating logistics demands of Central Vietnam and the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS).



PHASE 1
OBJECTIVES

To establish a state-of-the-art seaport complex featuring 04 core berths with a total quay length of 1,300 meters, fully capable of accommodating heavy-tonnage vessels. The phase focuses on synchronizing international-standard navigation channels and turning basins, alongside robust port protection structures and hinterland logistics infrastructure.

Equipped with advanced terminal operating technologies, the port will optimize its stevedoring efficiency, storage capacity, and cargo distribution. Comprehensive operational frameworks will be finalized to position My Thuy International Port as a strategically vital trade gateway for the region.

CORE SERVICES

A modern, high-performance port with versatile handling capabilities, designed for safe and efficient operations, accommodating vessels of up to 100,000 DWT.

CONTAINER CARGO 01. Dedicated berths and Ship-to-Shore (STS) cranes, optimizing vessel turnaround time to international standards.

BULK CARGO 02. Handles a wide range of bulk commodities, including woodchips, pellets, sand, ores, coal, and agricultural products.

BREAKBULK & PROJECT CARGO 03. Capable of handling oversized, overweight cargo and large-scale industrial equipment.

RO-RO SERVICES 04. Accommodates Ro-Ro vessels for the transportation of vehicles, machinery, and industrial equipment serving nearby industrial parks.

LIQUID BULK & LNG 05. Planned dedicated terminals to support the growing demand for clean energy across the economic zone.

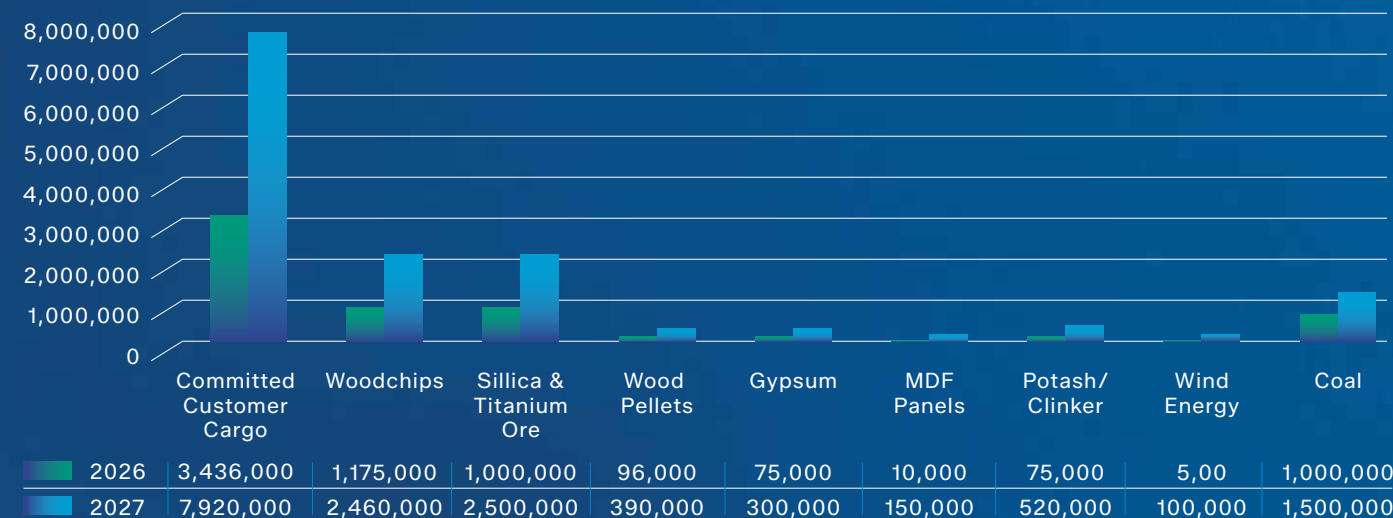
